



# Assistive Technology Summer Camp for Students Entering Grades 3-8, July 25-28, 2022

Students with reading and writing challenges often have great ideas but have trouble accessing information or getting their thoughts on paper. At our assistive technology summer camp students will be introduced to a variety of apps, extensions, software, and websites to help them read or write effectively.

Camp will include a pre-session 1/2 hour remote interview with each student to determine his/her individualized AT needs and a post-session 1/2 hour remote interview with parents to provide a summary of what was introduced at camp.

**Students will need to select a *focus*, Reading or Writing, when registering for camp.**

*Think it, Type/Speak it, Check it, Fix it* method will be utilized for students participating with a focus on Writing. This method can be tailored to the needs of the student using word prediction, speech recognition, and grammar check.

*Select It, Read it, Define it, Answer it* method will be utilized for students participating with a focus on Reading. This method can be tailored to the needs of the student using text-to-speech, definition, tools, highlighting tools, and annotation tools.

Session 1 hours: 12:45pm-2:00pm 3rd-5th grade students

Session 2 hours: 2:00pm-3:15pm 6th-8th grade students

Technology covered will be specifically applicable to the use of Chromebooks in the school environment. The camp will be taught by Hyde Park Day School instructors, who have expertise in accommodations for students with dyslexia. This camp is for children who would benefit from learning technology features that will accommodate difficulties in reading or writing. Students must bring a laptop or Chromebook.
